- 5) We had our 3rd annual Scholastic Book Fair at Cherokee. Our SEL Committee (Meredith Norman and Sarah Bass) and our Helping Hands coordinator Kim Walters recruited parent volunteers to help run the cash registers and bag books.
- 6) We had parent-teacher conferences. Our Staff Appreciation (Meals) Committee (Annie Ignoffo, Deanne Plattner, and Kistin Carruthers) coordinated a delicious dinner and breakfast for staff. The Greek Chicken Bowls were a huge hit!
- 7) We had our District 67 APT Annual Meeting at CROYA on March 11, where Ann Kiesling was voted in as the next Cherokee APT President!
- 8) The yearbook was submitted (woohoo!) and delivery is scheduled for mid-May. Thank you so much to our amazing yearbook team, Kelly Pasquesi, Gillian Goodriend, Erica Lumpp, and Annie Ignoffo, for all their hard work this year.
- 9) Unfortunately, we had to cancel Muffins with Mom, which was scheduled to take place on April 3. Checks were shredded and those who paid with cash will be reimbursed once school resumes. Thank you to Brianna Meade and Anne Axus for all your work on this -- and thank you for your flexibility.

Coming up...

1) We'll be sending out the Spring Volunteer Survey in May to gather names for beginning-of-the-school-year volunteer opportunities, such as Room Parents,

Evening Socials Hosts, Classroom Photographers, etc. We will be emailing this out to current K-3 families, as well as incoming K families. So be on the look-out!

- 2) Ann will now be taking over filling the Cherokee APT Board Roster for next year. If you are not currently on the Board, but are interested in joining next year, please contact Ann Kiesling. I will be following up with current Board members I haven't heard from yet about their intentions for next year.
- 3) For current Board members: Maria will be sending you your current job description to update. She will also be sending around a template for you to use to fill out your year-end report. Both things will be due May 1.
- 4) We are still planning to celebrate Staff Appreciation Week May 4-8. The Exec APT Board would like this week to look similar across all four District 67 schools. The current thought is to do fun, easy, virtual things to show the staff our appreciation throughout the week and plan for bigger celebrations once school resumes. Monday, April 13th a Card my Yard sign was placed in front of the school to give thanks to the teachers and staff that are coming to school to pick up some materials.

Brief Summary of Coming Month - Plans:

We are also planning for Staff Appreciation Week, every day for the students to make a drawing, card or video to send to the teachers virtually to thank them.

Staff Appreciation - Meals: Annie Ignoffo, Kristin Carruthers, Deanne Plattner

March 5th dinner: We served approximately 40 teachers in one seating at 5pm. Mr. Livingston's desire is for the full staff to eat together so both the teachers lounge and a conference room were used for seating. We served Greek Chicken Bowls with fresh vegetables, hummus, and tzatziki sauce for toppings. We had bottled water and LaCroix in the fridge and a "chocolate bar" for dessert with a variety of individually-wrapped mini chocolates and brownie bites with some cute to-go bags for teachers to put together. This meal was a huge success, some of the teachers commented it was their favorite staff meal ever!

Food breakdown: 32 chicken breasts, sliced and served in a chafer 1/2 pan each of white and brown rice served in a chafer

12 pita breads sliced into 6 pieces,6 GF pitas sliced into 6 pieces, (2) 10oz Feta Cheese crumbles, 3 sliced cucumbers, 3 sliced red peppers, 3 sliced red onions, 2 pints cherry tomatoes, 3 cans chickpeas, 2 bottles Greek Salad Dressing, Tzatziki Sauce, (4) 16oz assorted hummus, 3 bags pita chips (placed on dining tables)
48 bottles water, 48 LaCroix

6 bags chocolates candies, 48 brownie bites

Other: Plates, bowls, napkins, plastic cutlery, tongs, serving spoons, serving bowls, chafers (2), non-stick aluminum foil, to-go containers for leftovers (!!!), bags for chocolate treats

March 6th Light Breakfast: We had teachers grazing throughout the morning, approximately 30, with everything set up at 7:30. We kept breakfast simple and easy to grab and go, many teachers only had a half-hour time slot here and there to eat. It was much appreciated!

Food Breakdown: 24 muffins, 2 coffeecakes, 6 GF Baked goods 3qt sliced strawberries, 3 pints blueberries, 2 pints raspberries 16 Chobani Yogurt Flips (probably a few too many) 2 boxes granola, 1 bag GF granola (again, one box too many) K Cups- 36 count, 2 Specialty Creamer, 1 gallon OJ (1/2 gallon too much), milk

If we still have personal items at Cherokee, can we pick them up sometime? Yes, there will be a time for students/parents to come up at some point to pick up items or drop off items. We are unsure when that will be, but something will be planned once we can.

Are assignments getting graded? Attendance being taken?

Attendance is getting taken daily. This is done by students submitting work via Seesaw/Google docs for the day. Grading is also being done and students will get an end of year report card. However, grades (or checks) can only improve during this time period. No one will slide lower.

Has school been cancelled for the year?

No, school has not been cancelled for the year. We still have a tentative "go back" date of May 1. There is some split thinking among superintendents on what to do - go ahead and close for the year or try to go back. No decision has been made yet. If we do close, then e-learning will continue until June 5.

Will enrollment still be the same for August?

Yes, we are planning for school enrollment to still be as planned for the upcoming year. There may be some instances where children with pre-exisiting conditions have to do e-learning....but planning for the majority to begin the year normally.
